## Psalm 121<sup>iii</sup> Your Presence Till Journey's End

<sup>1</sup>I lift up my eyes to the hills; \* from where is my help to come? <sup>2</sup>My help comes from the LORD, \* the maker of heaven and earth. <sup>3</sup>He will not let your foot be moved \* and he who watches over you will not fall asleep. <sup>4</sup>Behold, he who keeps watch over Israel \* shall neither slumber nor sleep; <sup>5</sup>The Lord himself watches over you; \* the LORD is your shade at your right hand, <sup>6</sup>So that the sun shall not strike you by day, \* nor the moon by night. <sup>7</sup>The LORD shall preserve you from all evil; \* it is he who shall keep you safe. <sup>8</sup>The LORD shall watch over your going out and your coming in, \* from this time forth for evermore.

## "About the Psalm: Psalm 121

This psalm is in dialogue form, possibly between a group of worshippers and a priest, perhaps as a blessing at their arrival at or departure from the temple. The LORD, the Creator, will watch over the people day and night.

Another thought: The psalmist knows the divine Presence as a life-long companion upon the way. No matter what befalls the pilgrim, the divine Guide the sojourner alone
