⁹Have mercy on me, O LORD, for I am in trouble; * my eye is consumed with sorrow, and also my throat and my belly. 10 For my life is wasted with grief, and my years with sighing; * my strength fails me because of affliction, and my bones are consumed. ¹¹I have become a reproach to all my enemies and even to my neighbors, a dismay to those of my acquaintance; * when they see me in the street they avoid me. ¹²I am forgotten like a dead man, out of mind; * I am as useless as a broken pot. ¹³For I have heard the whispering of the crowd; fear is all around; * they put their heads together against me; they plot to take my life. ¹⁴But as for me, I have trusted in you, O LORD. * I have said, "You are my God. ¹⁵My times are in your hand; * rescue me from the hand of my enemies, and from those who persecute me. ¹⁶Make your face to shine upon your servant, * and in your loving-kindness save me."

About the Psalm: Psalm 31:9-16
