

## Psalm 105:1-6, 37-45<sup>iii</sup>

<sup>1</sup>Give thanks to the LORD and call upon his Name; \*  
make known his deeds among the peoples.

<sup>2</sup>Sing to him, sing praises to him, \*  
and speak of all his marvelous works.

<sup>3</sup>Glory in his holy Name; \*  
let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice.

<sup>3</sup>Search for the LORD and his strength; \*  
continually seek his face.

<sup>4</sup>Remember the marvels he has done, \*  
his wonders and the judgments of his mouth,

<sup>5</sup>O offspring of Abraham his servant, \*  
O children of Jacob his chosen.

<sup>6</sup>He led out his people with silver and gold; \*  
in all their tribes there was not one that stumbled.

<sup>37</sup>Egypt was glad of their going, \*  
because they were afraid of them.

<sup>38</sup>He spread out a cloud for a covering \*  
and a fire to give light in the night season.

<sup>39</sup>They asked, and quails appeared, \*  
and he satisfied them with bread from heaven.

<sup>40</sup>He opened the rock, and water flowed, \*  
so the river ran in the dry places.

<sup>41</sup>For God remembered his holy word \*  
and Abraham his servant.

<sup>42</sup>So he led forth his people with gladness, \*  
his chosen with shouts of joy.

<sup>43</sup>He gave his people the lands of the nations, \*  
and they took the fruit of others' toil,

<sup>44</sup>That they might keep his statutes \*  
and observe his laws.

### <sup>iii</sup> **About Psalm 105:1-6, 37-45**

This hymn praises God who promised the land of Canaan to the covenant people and then kept the promise. The people are invited to praise God and seek God's presence (vv. 1-6) The whole story of the land “from the original promise to Abraham (vv. 7-11), to the ancestors in Canaan (vv. 12-15), Joseph in Egypt (vv. 16-22), Israel in Egypt (vv. 23-38) and Israel in the wilderness (39-45)” reveals how faithful God always was to the original promise.
