

Psalm 130ⁱⁱⁱ

¹Out of the depths have I called to you, O LORD; Lord, hear my voice; *
let your ears consider well the voice of my supplication.

²If you, LORD, were to note what is done amiss, *

³O Lord, who could stand? For there is forgiveness with you; *
therefore you shall be feared.

⁴I wait for the LORD; my soul waits for him; *
in his word is my hope.

⁵My soul waits for the LORD, more than watchmen for the morning, *
more than watchmen for the morning.

⁶O Israel, wait for the LORD, *
for with the LORD there is mercy;

⁷With him there is plenteous redemption, *
and he shall redeem Israel from all their sins.

ⁱⁱⁱ About the Psalm: Psalm 130

This psalm is a lament, a plea for deliverance from unspecified trouble. The psalmist makes an implicit confession of sin (vv. 1-3), puts his trust in the Lord and exhorts the community to do likewise.
