¹Give thanks to the LORD and call upon his Name; * make known his deeds among the peoples. ²Sing to him, sing praises to him, * and speak of all his marvelous works. ³Glory in his holy Name; * let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice. ⁴Search for the LORD and his strength; * continually seek his face. ⁵Remember the marvels he has done, * his wonders and the judgments of his mouth, ⁶O offspring of Abraham his servant, * O children of Jacob his chosen. ²³Israel came into Egypt, * and Jacob became a sojourner in the land of Ham. ²⁴The LORD made his people exceedingly fruitful; * he made them stronger than their enemies; ²⁵Whose heart he turned, so that they hated his people, * and dealt unjustly with his servants. ²⁶He sent Moses his servant, * and Aaron whom he had chosen. Hallelujah!

This hymn praises God who promised the land of Canaan to the covenant people and then kept the promise. The people are invited to praise God and seek God's presence (vv. 1-6) The whole story of the land—from the original promise to Abraham (vv. 7-11), to the ancestors in

Canaan (vv. 12-15), Joseph in Egypt (vv. 16-22), Israel in Egypt (vv. 23-38) and Israel in the wilderness (39-45)—reveals how faithful God always was to the original promise.
